Dr. Klaus Wellershoff will cover the macro-economic environment and examine expected wage and salary increases by sector. UBS has published the Personnel Compensation study for more than 15 years, and the results have had a high predictive value for the development of compensation costs in Switzerland. This outlook will be of high interest in light of high demands from the Swiss unions. Dr. Wellershoff will also comment on the crucial link between salary increases and the development of the Swiss economy.

The foreseeable demographic stagnation of Europe and also of Switzerland will make it increasingly difficult to guarantee an enduring increase in living standards and economic prosperity. However, that does not mean that Europe is virtually condemned to become a grandiose retirement home. Dr. Hans Groth will show how Europe can counter these demographic challenges.
